Essays of the January 1943 series of Tobacco stamps.

Essays printed in black are recently (2024) discovered. The type number below refers to the type number written on the sheet above the essays. Below type 1 on the sheet are the following written comments. Start print in January 1943. For value 1, 2 and 3 satang the print in black color, for value of 4 satang the print in green color, for value of 5 satang the print in blue color and the value of 10 satang, the print in red color. It is not sure if this comment belongs to Type 1 stamps. Anyhow of the few known stamps of this 1943 series, all 4 types follow this color scheme. These stamps were never announced in any Royal Gazette issue. I am not sure which types and values were actually issued, since lots of these old stamps did not survive the times. However below is a listing of all known stamps.

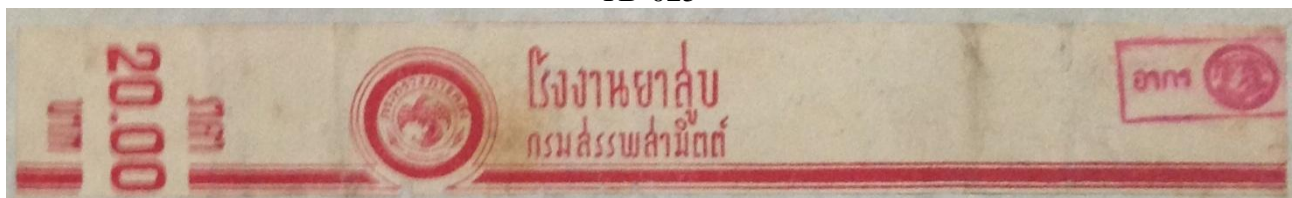

These stamps are not described in a Gazette announcement. The issue date is unknown – probably W.W.II era. They have been seen in 4 values. The values are large, so they must have been used on large packs or bulk tobacco. The 15- baht value has been seen on a “The Three Castles” and “Clipper” brands of cigarettes in cans of 50, imported from England. The medallion is not centered on the stamp, but is near the left end. The values are printed vertically on the left end of the stamp. There are 3 red lines (narrow, wide, narrow) to the right of Baht – in Thai, and below the medallion. The text to the right of the medallion reads “Tobacco Monopoly; Excise Department”. There are handstamps in red similar to TH-001 thru TH-005 on the right end of the long stamp.

<p>These stamps are unusual for several reasons. They are not described in a Gazette announcement. Their issue date is unknown. They have been seen in only two values printed in red ink on white paper. The printing is not sharp and appears to have been done locally. These stamps have been seen used on packages of “The Three Castles” and “Navy Cut Tobacco” (3.00 baht) and “Double Ace” (2.50 baht) brands of cigarettes imported from England. The medallion is not centered on the stamp. The medallion contains an image of a WaYuPhak bird and an inscription at the top that reads “Ministry of Finance”. The text on the right side reads “โรงงานยาสูบ” (Tobacco Monopoly) above the four horizontal lines and “กรมสรรพสามิต” (Excise Department) below the horizontal lines.</p>

The first rubber handstamps for the Thailand Tobacco Monopoly



Until 7 September 1943, the Thailand Tobacco Monopoly or TTM had used tobacco stamps on their products. But on that date the TTM was instead allowed to use a rubber handstamp on two brands of their cigarettes.


These were the 'กล่อง' (Box) and 'ปรางค์สามยอด' (Three Stupas) brands of cigarettes.

On 21 October 1943, the TTM was authorized to use 3 additional rubber handstamps on the various brands they produced.

First Tobacco revenue stamps printed overseas after the war.








After a gap of several years in printing tobacco revenue stamps, during which some of the handstamps described before were used, on January 1950 the first new tobacco stamps were issued. These were the first stamps after World War 2 which were printed abroad in the UK by Bradbury Wilkinsons. There are 3 different types, issued with the type written in Thai numerals on the very right side of the stamp.

Type ๑ or 1 to be used for tobacco produced in Thailand







Type ๒ or 2 to be used for small tobacco factories in Thailand making less than 200 cigarettes per day

Type ๓ or 3 to be used on tobacco imports from foreign countries.

It is not sure whom printed those stamps, but I believe it was either Thomas De La Rue or Bradbury Wilkinson.
