

Air-conditioner Revenue Stamps 2005

Because they are considered luxury goods, air-conditioners need a revenue stamp.

This requirement already exists since the early 1990's.

The stamps are stuck tight onto the side of the unit and are very difficult to remove in 1 piece, for this reason they are seldom shown in collections.

The stamps stuck on the Compressor unit are numbered starting with CD and the once stuck onto the side of the Fan Coil unit, start with FC.

The stamps below show the word "void" all over the stamp after peeling off.
