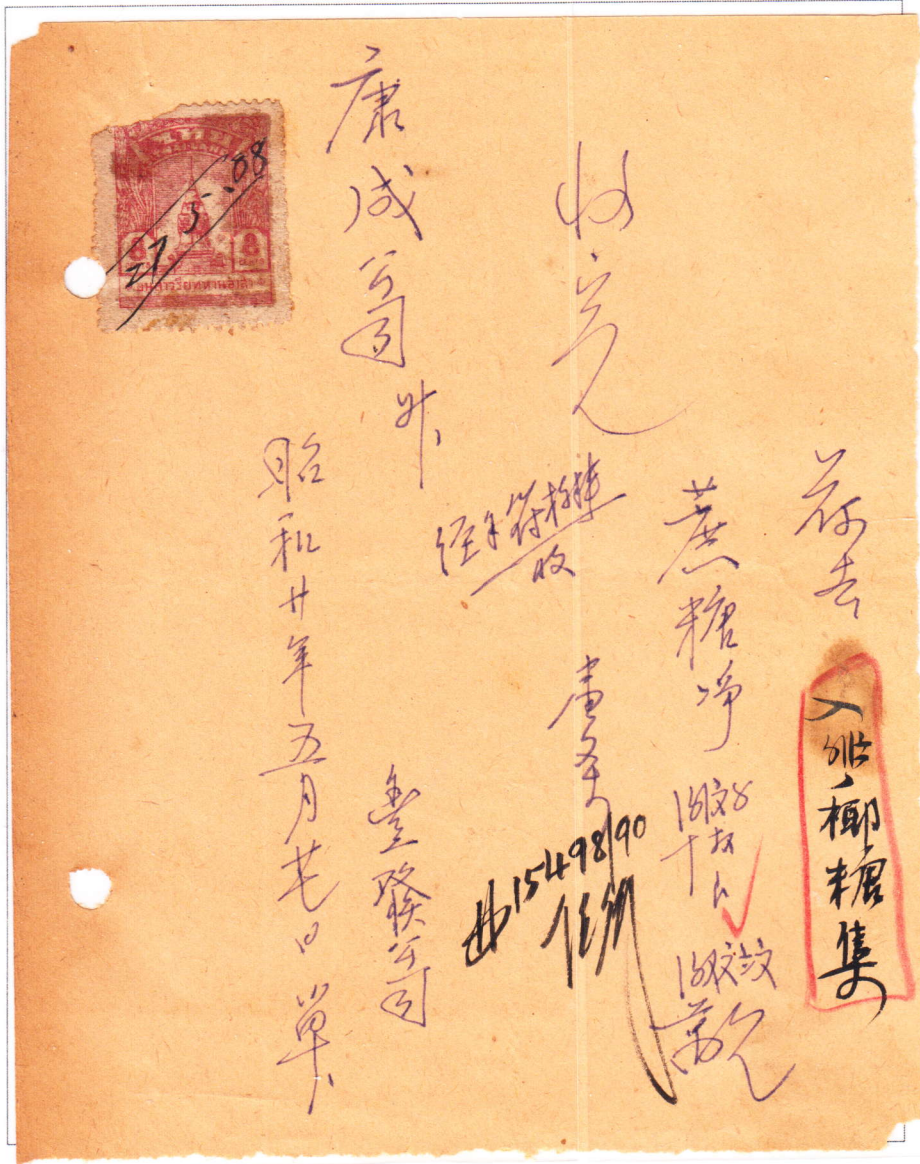


Occupation Kedah 1943 - 1945

On October 18, 1943, the Japanese ceded administrative control over Kedah to the Thai government. The Thai starting using their old name, Syburi, instead of Kedah. There is only 1 revenue stamp issued for Syburi. This stamp is issued probably in 1945 and is seen on documents after June 1945. Before 1945, postage stamps from the Thai occupation of Malaya were used as revenue stamps. After the defeat of the Japanese, Kedah receded back to Malaya. on September 18, 1945

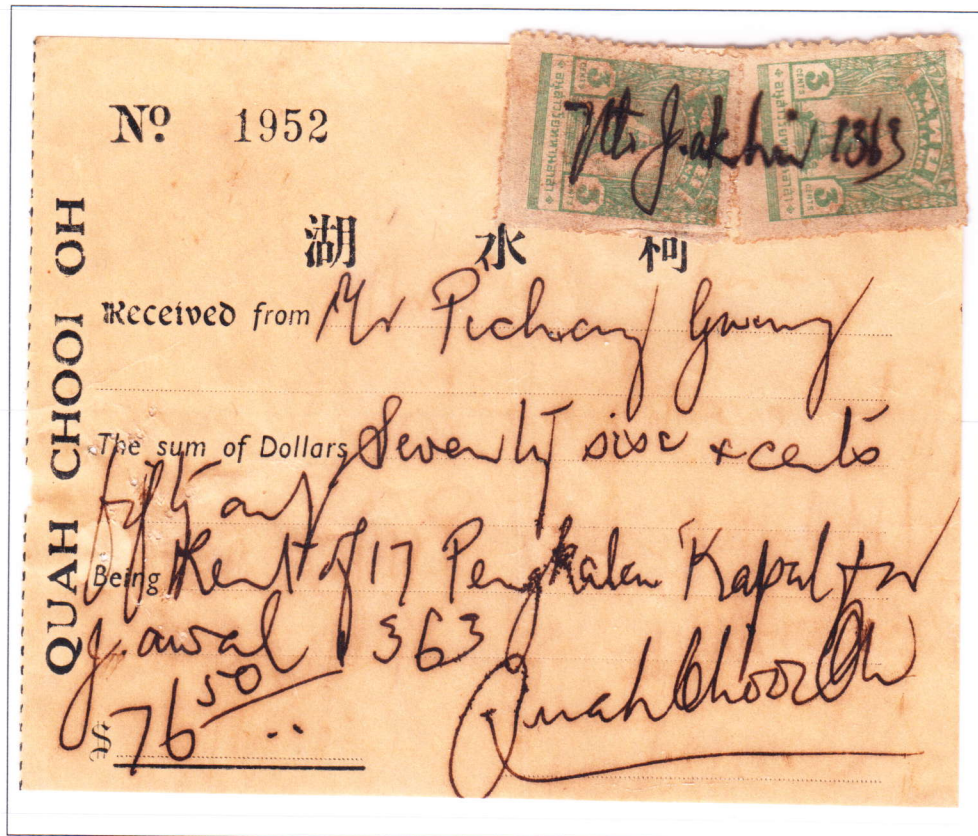

Issued on May 22, 1944. This was during the Thai Occupation of Malaya.
The document does use a postal occupation stamps of 8 cents. This is a
late use, the actual revenue stamp was issued in June 1944.

Thai Occupation of Kedah Document 1944

Kedah did not use revenue stamps till the issue of June 1945..
Before June 1945, they used Thai Occupation postal stamps as revenues



6 cents on rental receipt 11 May 1944

Rental receipt from Kedah with the date 17 Pengkalem 1363 in Jawi. This translates to 11 May 1944. Pengkalem is the local Kedah spelling for Jumadil Awal, the 5th months of the Islamic calendar. The receipt has 2 postal occupation stamps of 3 cents each used as provisional revenue stamps.

Occupation Kedah 1943 - 1945

The first revenue stamp for Kedah was printed in 1945 and it is seen on documents starting June 1945. The stamps are issued in sheets of 50 (5 x 10) and are issued without gum

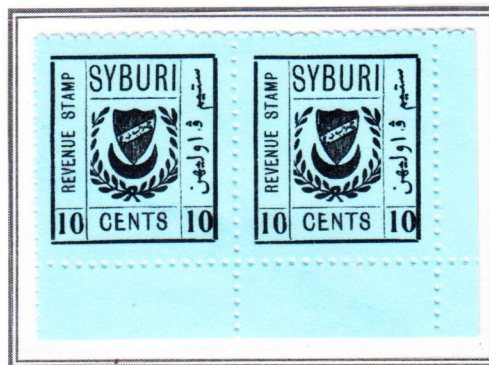

Occupation Kelantan First Issue 1943 - 1945

On October 18, 1943, the Japanese ceded control over Kelantan to the Thai government. New postage and revenue stamps were issued by the Kelantan State Treasury and were printed by the Kelantan Printing Department.

The postage stamps were put up for sale in Kota Bharu on Nov 15, 1943. Postage stamps were printed with a purple color coat of arms and the revenue stamps with a similar coat of arms in a light red color. Both postage and revenue stamps were printed in sheets of 7X12 or 84 stamps on watermarked paper from the British Crown Agents. Each right bottom corner of the sheet shows a watermark covering a total of 6 stamps. The revenue stamps have the stars in the coat of arms partially filled in, similar with one of the subtypes of the postage stamps. The coat of Arms revenue stamps were used till middle of 1945. After the defeat of the Japanese in 1945, Kelantan returned back to British Malaya on September 4, 1945.

Occupation Kelantan First Issue 1943 - 1945

In 1943, postage and revenue stamps with a similar design were printed for use in Kelantan. The printing was done in Kota Bahru using paper watermarked with the Crown Property Agents mark. The stamps show a coat of arms with on the top and bottom of the stamps a description in Jawi lettering. The postage stamps have the coat of arms in purple while the revenue stamps have it in pink. The value is printed in the middle of the bottom text. The first letter to the right of the value is very different between postage and revenue stamp. There seems to be 3 different printings, with the star on top of the coat of arms either blank, partially or completely filled in.

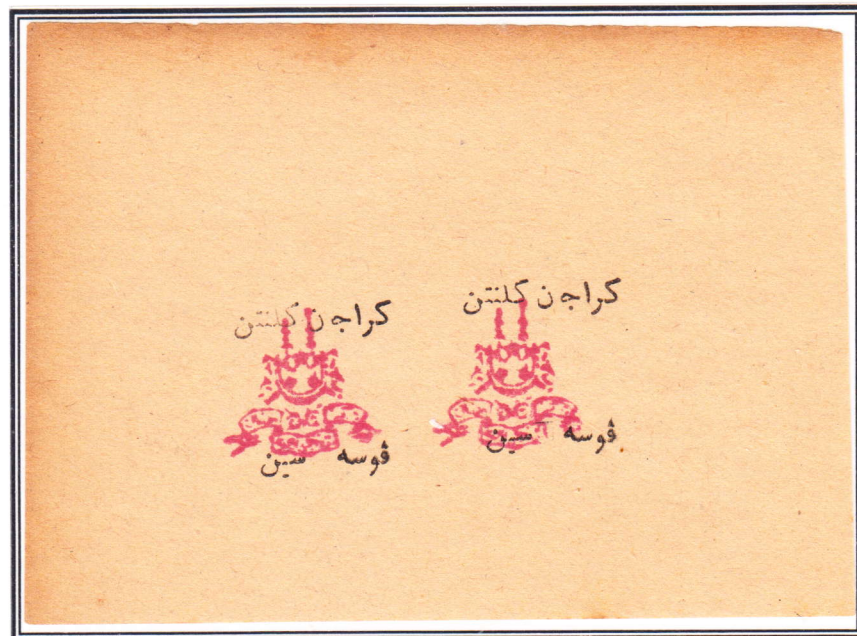

Occupation Kelantan Second Issue 1944 - 1945

This is a lithographed stamp with the frame design copied from a pre-war issue. The stamp portraits Sultan Tengku Ibrahim. The Thai word on top of the stamp reads Kelantan. the stamps are issued without gum. Besides the 8 Cents, all other values are very rare. Below the original 1937 Kelantan stamps used for the frame design.

Thai Occupation of Kelantan Fakes

Below set of 10 stamps are fake copies of the blue series of the Kelantan revenue stamps issued in 1944. The stamps show the portrait of the sultan of Kelantan. The top of the stamps show the words, state of Kelantan. All 10 stamps have the value of 8 cents, These stamps have crude perforations, many times misplaced.

There are similar fake sets with the same sultan of Kelantan portrait with on the top reading Perlis and 1 set reading Syburi. The Syburi stamps have all a denomination of 4 cents and the Perlis a denomination of 2 cents.

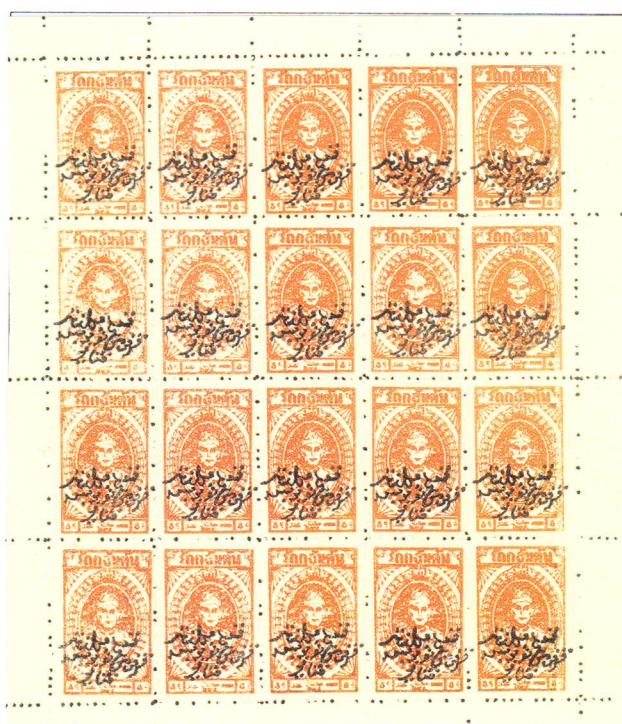
There seems to be a lot of different fakes existing of the Sultan Tenku Ibrahim revenue stamps. It is quite unclear what the purpose was. The fakes are of such a poor quality that it is impossible to cheat collectors with those stamps.

From all the fakes existing, the stamps below with the black overprint are most interesting. The black text is Arabic and supposed to read "Postal Service Pattani".

Many of those stamps were for sale in the Spink Auction, Singapore June 2007.

They were for sale in many variations in 10 different colors in sheets of 20.

Estimated price was Sing \$10,000 - \$12,000 for 10 different color sheets.

Documents of the Shan states issued Jan 6, 1945. The document is a receipt for the the hiring of 8 porters to carry goods for sale. Total payment was 12 baht. The trip took 9 days. The Shan states had hardly any paved roads during that time. The document has one 5 satang orange Saharat Thai Derm occupation stamp. In addition there is a 5 satang brown Public Welfare charity stamp. Documents having this additional stamp are very rare.

Occupation Trengganu 1943 - 1945

Cancelled ship revenues on or off document are very rare. For a long time they were thought not to exist.

Below Trengganu revenue stamps are cancelled, Kuala Trengganu on 12 June 1944. The cancel is bi-lingual in English and Jawi and has an oval shape.

In addition to above stamps, another cancelled 1 dollar stamps is found. The cancel has a similar oval shape is also bi-lingual but the date is not legible.

In March, 2018, the first ever seen document, issued for a land transfer, was sold in Auction at Eurseree for USD4,500. It has a single 50 cents ship stamp, also cancelled with an oval Kuala Trengganu cancel. Dated September 27, 1945 which is 3 days after Trengganu receded back to Malaya.

Occupation Trengganu 50 Dollar Varieties

The Trengganu ship revenues were printed in 1943 when Trengganu was transferred from Japanese control to Thai control. From the 15 different values printed, only the 2 highest values the 50 and 100 Dollar are printed on watermarked paper. Printed in sheets of 25 (5 X 5) stamps, the right lower corner of the sheets has a watermark as shown in the illustration below.

Occupation Trengganu 3 Dollar Varieties

In the year 2002, the exhibitor has seen at a dealers store in Bangkok some 15 sheets of the 3 Dollar ship revenue stamps. Each sheet containing 25 stamps. Most of the sheets had the value tablet blank. Some sheets fully perforated some inperforated and a few sheets had only a few perforation lines, badly aligned.

Also on 2 of the sheets some stamps had a value 50 printed in a font type different with the issued stamps.

Typed notations with this set of sheets explained that the sheets were used to set up the perforation machine and were also used by the printer to select the best fitting font for the 50 Dollar stamps.

Thai Occupation of Laos 1941-1946, Champasak

Following the Franco- Thai War from October 1940 - January 1941, The French Vichy regime ceded control of parts of Laos and Cambodia to Thailand.

During the THai Occupation, no specoil postal stamps were issued but the he stamps from Thailand were used. This is a Court Document dated 20 May 1942, issued in Champasak in South-West Laos The cancellation on the 2 documentary stamps reads Champasak. On the back of the document are Court Fee stamps and also the word Champasak.

Occupation documents from Occupied Laos are very rare.
