Text in the left segment reads ไพ่ป๊อกต่างประเทศ (Foreign Playing Cards). The upper medallion reads “Ministry of Finance, Thailand”. The bottom reads “Excise Department”. The right segment reads “Fee already paid by means of this stamp”. ไพ่ป๊อก (Pai Pak) is used for Western style playing cards as opposed to “Pai Tong” (Thai style cards with 120 cards to a deck), or “Pai Chine” (Chinese cards).

A 35 degree/ 0.1875 liter AD-5050.A1 Domestic Mekhong Alcohol stamp overprinted for foreign playing cards. Black text in the left segment reads “Foreign Playing cards”. The upper medallion reads “Ministry of Finance, Thailand”. The bottom reads “Excise Department”. The right segment reads “Fee already paid by means of this stamp” (referring to the small square handstamp in red).

A completely new design. Black text in the left segment reads ไพ่ยอกต่างประเทศ (Foreign Playing Cards). The upper medallion reads “Ministry of Finance, Thailand”. The bottom reads “Excise Department”. The right segment reads ชำระค่าประทับตราแล้ว (Fee already paid by means of this stamp). NOTE: “stamp” in this case refers to the red square handstamps, not the label. There are 4 vertical rows of perforations, each consisting of 5 holes.

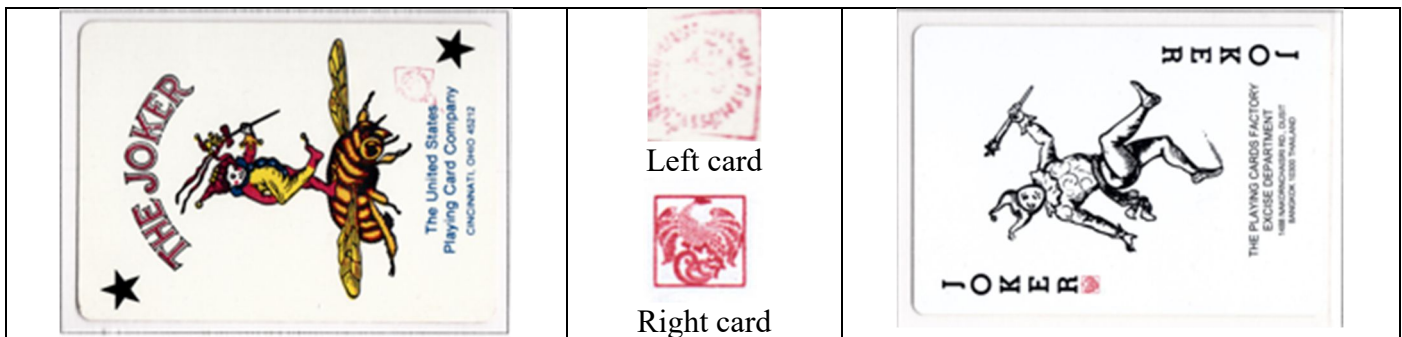

The 2 playing cards shown have both a red control mark representing the logo of the excise department. Originally this logo was hand stamped on each card of the deck and also on the revenue stamp itself. In later years, it was printed on the card as part of the printing process.

The right section reads ชำระค่าประทับตราแล้ว (Tax already paid). PC-0400.B is printed on white paper. The original text is in medium blue. PC-0400.C is printed on yellow paper and the original text is in dark blue. PC-0400.D has violet border, black original text and background, and a blue center design.

AM-6110.A5 Mixed Alcoholic Beverage stamp (40 degree / 0.300 liters) overprinted for use on foreign playing cards. The red overprint on the left reads “Foreign Playing Cards”. The red overprint on the right reads “Fee already paid by means of this stamp.” Note there is a small square handstamp added in black or red – twice on this strip and on each playing card in the deck. This is the “stamp” referred to in the Thai text on the right. These stamps – with black square handstamp - were seen on playing cards used as a promotion with bottles of Carlo Rossi Red Wine during October 2001. Stamp with red square handstamps were seen in January, 2002 on the regular plastic boxes of cards.

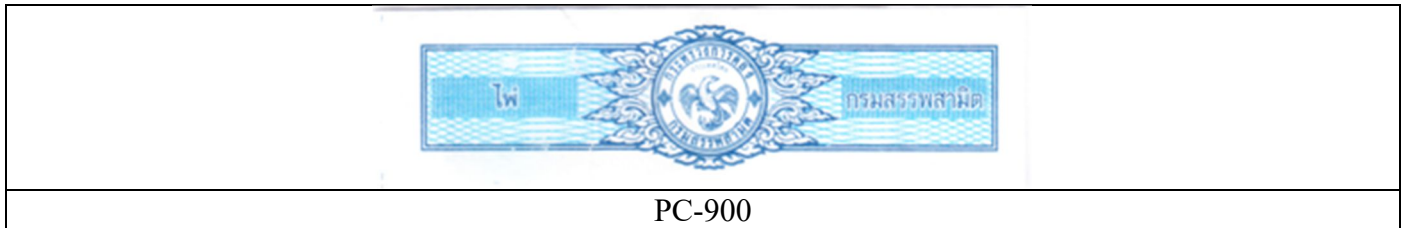

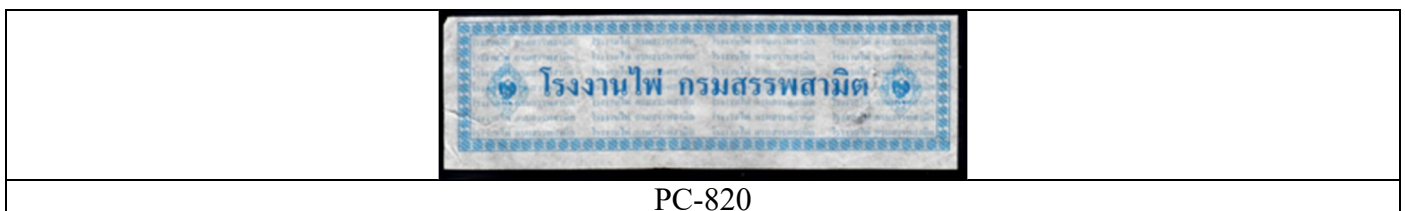

Large seals found on bulk packs of Chinese Playing Cards

An orange label from a package of Chinese style Thai playing cards and a selection of samples of the actual cards. Each pack of cards is composed of 60 cards – some which have Thai numbers on them. A deck consists of two packs, or 120 cards. One pack has an orange back, and the other has a green back. Four decks are bundled together in a pack and wrapped in white paper with an orange label. Each pack is sealed with a large PC-0800 seal of the Excise Department.
